# Before you attempt hazardous spill cleanup, take these precautions:

- Assess the spill and select proper personal protective equipment.
- If possible, stop the source of the spill.

## Follow these easy steps to assure maximum effectiveness:

#### 1. Contain the spill

Contain the spill by surrounding it with PIG HazMat Absorbent Socks and Dikes.

#### 2. Absorb the contained spill

Absorb the contained spill with PIG HazMat Pillows for large-volume spills and PIG HazMat Pads, Rolls and Pulp for smaller-volume spills.


#### 3. Dispose of used absorbents


Dispose of used absorbents in compliance with local and country regulations.
